As in 2007, stationary fuel cells systems will be a main focus of the upcoming HANNOVER MESSE 2008. BAXI Innotech, Hexis, Plug Power, Nedstack, Vaillant and Viessmann will showcase their progress with this technology. In field tests these systems have achieved 1000+ hours in operation.

Recognized as the world's largest energy and industry trade fair, the HANNOVER MESSE 2008 will welcome over 5000 exhibitors from April 21st till 25th.
